

# Campground Information

## Benefit Concert 2017

The Visitors Center will be closed to the general public after 4:00 p.m. There will be **“No Right Turns”** into the Visitors Center Driveway (Driveway #1) after 4:00 p.m.

There will be a shuttle between the South Farm House (camping) and the main campus (concert). Please park at campground and take shuttle to concert. Shuttle will return you to campground after concert, leaving from the Lillian Goldman Visitors Center. Shuttle hours are 5-7 p.m. and 10-11 p.m., leaving & arriving every 30 minutes.

**Due to the “Tobacco Mosaic Virus” use of tobacco product is prohibited on Seed Savers Exchange grounds.**

Your campground host will be staying in sites near the check-in canopy.

Cell phones may not receive a signal in the camping areas. Please contact Campground Host in the event of an emergency. They will help direct EMS to the proper site. **The farmhouse will be used as a shelter in case of severe storms. Campground host will have a key.**

Cars should maintain a speed limit of 10 MPH, and take caution near the many blind corners along the roads.

Please stay on the trails while hiking around.

No fires... only small portable camp stoves.

**Please camp and park only in designated campsites.** Car must be parked on your designated campsite. Sites will be assigned.

Always clean up after yourselves.

Quiet hours are between 12:00 midnight – 7:00 a.m.

Portable Restrooms are located near the Camping Areas.

This is a primitive campsite, **there are no showers available and no electricity.**

The camping areas are near and around gardens. Please do not remove or damage anything in the gardens. Many of the vegetables growing are rare varieties and are being grown to produce seed for conservation purposes. There may be electric fences in use.
